- ❖ Strives to make a positive impact by identifying and fulfilling a community need or concern.



Eligibility

- ❖ Must be individual citizens, communities, businesses or churches in the City of Hardeeville city limits.
- ❖ Over the age of 21.
- ❖ Member of the community in good standing.



Not Eligible

- ❖ Previous winners
- ❖ Elected Officials
- ❖ City Employees
- ❖ Memorial awards will not be given in honor of a deceased Hardeeville citizen.
- ❖ Persons that enter a plea for a crime, sexual offense, felons, misdemeanors or are involved in a pending court case.
- ❖ Owe taxes or fees



Nomination Process

- ❖ Nomination window is January 1-January 31.
- ❖ Advertised on our Website and Social Media.
- ❖ Forms will be available on line and at City Hall.
- ❖ Amount of nominations for the same person will have no effect on the outcome.
- ❖ All additional documentation to support the nomination such as news articles or video clips should also be submitted.



Selection Process

- ❖ Reviewed by Committee to determine winner and honorable mention.
- ❖ All nominees will be considered who meet or exceed the nomination criteria.
- ❖ All nominees will receive a letter informing them of the winner and honorable mention,
- ❖ The Winner will be announced at the first City Council Meeting in February.
- ❖ Annual Award



Additional Recognition

- ❖ Introduced on the City's website and social media.
- ❖ There will be a perpetual award plaque maintained at City Hall to reflect current and past winners.
- ❖ Grand Marshal at the Holiday parade.
- ❖ Will arrange coverage on local news and prepare a press release.
- ❖ Will receive a Proclamation from the Mayor.
- ❖ Yard sign displayed until March 1.
